CLARENCE DARROW TO BE AGAIN TRIED.

The third trial of Clarence Darrow has been set by the Los Angeles Court to commence a couple of months hence.

It is doubtful whether our members fully realize the enormous expense that these trials have amounted to, or what it has meant to Mr. Darrow in having to bear them alone. They have gone high into the thousands of dol-

lars and to use his own language, "it has about cleaned him out of money." Therefore, we believe that the working people should go to his assistance and furnish the necessary amount for his further defense.

It is generally recognized that this venomous persecution of him is inspired and backed up by the National Erectors Association, the Steel Trust and other like bodies, as a result of the hatred they bear him because of the able fights he has made in defense of labor in the past. They have used this alleged bribery charge to try to crush him, not only to prevent him from making any more fights in their behalf, but to serve as a warning to others that might feel a sympathy for the poor and oppressed.

The working people of the United States realize and appreciate the past efforts of Mr. Darrow too much to allow his foes to crush him for lack of funds to provide an adequate defense in his next trial and will no doubt supply him with the necessary funds.

Appeals have gone out and we hope that our members will do their full duty when answering the appeal.
