Now comes the above named respondents, by Rowlette, Perry and Mahoney, their attorneys, respectively, and move the Court to admit the above named respondents to bail for the following reasons:

I.

Because the admittance to bail of the above named respondents is discretionary with the Court.

II.

Because from the preliminary examination as shown by the files and records in this Court in this Cause, it is apparent that proof of the defendants' guilt is not evident, nor is the presumption great.

III.

Because the above respondents are substantial citizens of the City of Detroit and have been continuous residents of this City for a number of years and bear good reputations for being peaceful and law-abiding citizens.

IV.
